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- After finishing the book for the first time, ask children which was their favourite Incy Wincy adventure. Ask them why it was their favourite adventure.
- As you read the story a second time, introduce the Incy Wincy Spider tune when you see the music symbol
   Encourage children to hear the rhyming words by pausing at certain places in the song and waiting for them to say the word that finishes the line.
   For example:

Incy Wincy Spider was in a playful mood, and saw some chickens foraging for \_\_\_\_\_ (food).

He dangled in between them, swinging in the breeze...

but nearly got gobbled, escaping to the\_\_\_\_(trees).

- As you read the story again, revise days of the week by asking 'Which day of the week comes next?
- Encourage discussion about spiders by asking children if they have ever walked or run through a spider's web.

  This could introduce research about how spiders make their webs and/or a discussion about insect and spider safety in the garden.
